

Cookie Policy of 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal

This document informs Users about the technologies that help 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal to achieve the purposes described below. Such technologies allow the Owner to access and store information (for example by using a Cookie) or use resources (for example by running a script) on a User's device as they interact with 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal.

For simplicity, all such technologies are defined as "Trackers" within this document – unless there is a reason to differentiate. For example, while Cookies can be used on both web and mobile browsers, it would be inaccurate to talk about Cookies in the context of mobile apps as they are a browser-based Tracker. For this reason, within this document, the term Cookies is only used where it is specifically meant to indicate that particular type of Tracker.

Some of the purposes for which Trackers are used may also require the User's consent. Whenever consent is given, it can be freely withdrawn at any time following the instructions provided in this document.

3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal uses Trackers managed directly by the Owner (so-called "first-party" Trackers) and Trackers that enable services provided by a third-party (so-called "third-party" Trackers). Unless otherwise specified within this document, third-party providers may access the Trackers managed by them.

The validity and expiration periods of Cookies and other similar Trackers may vary depending on the lifetime set by the Owner or the relevant provider. Some of them expire upon termination of the User's browsing session.

In addition to what's specified in the descriptions within each of the categories below, Users may find more precise and updated information regarding lifetime specification as well as any other relevant information — such as the presence of other Trackers — in the linked privacy policies of the respective third-party providers or by contacting the Owner.

Activities strictly necessary for the operation of 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal and delivery of the Service

3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal uses so-called "technical" Cookies and other similar Trackers to carry out activities that are strictly necessary for the operation or delivery of the Service.

Third-party Trackers

Traffic optimization and distribution

This type of service allows 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal to distribute their content using servers located across different countries and to optimize their performance.

Which Personal Data are processed depends on the characteristics and the way these services are implemented. Their function is to filter communications between 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal and the User's browser.

Considering the widespread distribution of this system, it is difficult to determine the locations to which the contents that may contain Personal Information of the User are transferred.

Cloudflare (Cloudflare Inc.)

Cloudflare is a traffic optimization and distribution service provided by Cloudflare Inc.

The way Cloudflare is integrated means that it filters all the traffic through 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal, i.e., communication between 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal and the User's browser, while also allowing analytical data from 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal to be collected.

Personal Data processed: Cookies and various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Handling payments

Unless otherwise specified, 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal processes any payments by credit card, bank transfer or other means via external payment service providers. In general and unless where otherwise stated, Users are requested to provide their payment details and personal information directly to such payment service providers. 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal isn't involved in the collection and processing of such information: instead, it will only receive a notification by the relevant payment service provider as to whether payment has been successfully completed.

Freshbooks (2NDSITE Inc.)

Freshbooks is an invoicing and payment service provided by 2NDSITE Inc.

Personal Data processed: billing address, email address, first name, last name, payment info, phone number, purchase history, shipping address, Tracker, Usage Data and various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

SPAM protection

User database management

This type of service allows the Owner to build user profiles by starting from an email address, a personal name, or other information that the User provides to 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal, as well as to track User activities through analytics features. This Personal Data may also be matched with publicly available information about the User (such as social networks' profiles) and used to build private profiles that the Owner can display and use for improving 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal.

Some of these services may also enable the sending of timed messages to the User, such as emails based on specific actions performed on 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal.

How to manage preferences and provide or withdraw consent

There are various ways to manage Tracker related preferences and to provide and withdraw consent, where relevant:

Additionally, whenever the use of Trackers is based on consent, Users can provide or withdraw such consent by setting their preferences within the cookie notice or by updating such preferences accordingly via the relevant consent-preferences privacy widget, if available.

It is also possible, via relevant browser or device features, to delete previously stored Trackers, including those used to remember the User's initial consent preferences.

Other Trackers in the browser's local memory may be cleared by deleting the browsing history.

With regard to any third-party Trackers, Users can manage their preferences via the related opt-out link (where provided), by using the means indicated in the third party's privacy policy, or by contacting the third party.

However, please note that Trackers help 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal to provide a better experience and advanced functionalities to Users (in line with the purposes outlined in this document). Therefore, if the User chooses to block the use of Trackers, the Owner may be unable to provide related features.

Personal Data (or Data)

Any information that directly, indirectly, or in connection with other information — including a personal identification number — allows for the identification or identifiability of a natural person.

Usage Data

Information collected automatically through 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal (or third-party services employed in 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal), which can include: the IP addresses or domain names of the computers utilized by the Users who use 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal, the URI addresses (Uniform Resource Identifier), the time of the request, the method utilized to submit the request to the server, the size of the file received in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the server's answer (successful outcome, error, etc.), the country of origin, the features of the browser and the operating system utilized by the User, the various time details per visit (e.g., the time spent on each page within the Application) and the details about the path followed within the Application with special reference to the sequence of pages visited, and other parameters about the device operating system and/or the User's IT environment.

User

The individual using 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal who, unless otherwise specified, coincides with the Data Subject.

Data Subject

The natural person to whom the Personal Data refers.

Data Processor (or Processor)

The natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which processes Personal Data on behalf of the Controller, as described in this privacy policy.

Data Controller (or Owner)

The natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing of Personal Data, including the security measures concerning the operation and use of 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal. The Data Controller, unless otherwise specified, is the Owner of 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal.

3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal (or this Application)

The means by which the Personal Data of the User is collected and processed.

Service

The service provided by 3130 Design & 3130 Design Client Portal as described in the relative terms (if available) and on this site/application.

European Union (or EU)

Unless otherwise specified, all references made within this document to the European Union include all current member states to the European Union and the European Economic Area.

Cookie

Cookies are Trackers consisting of small sets of data stored in the User's browser.

Tracker

Tracker indicates any technology - e.g Cookies, unique identifiers, web beacons, embedded scripts, e-tags and fingerprinting - that enables the tracking of Users, for example by accessing or storing information on the User's device.

Legal information

This privacy statement has been prepared based on provisions of multiple legislations.
