Eyezly.me collects some Personal Data from its Users.

Types of Data collected

Among the types of Personal Data that eyezly.me collects, by itself or through third parties, there are: Usage Data; Trackers; username; device information; email address; various types of Data; general activity data; Camera permission; Microphone permission; Phone permission; Photo Library permission; password.

Complete details on each type of Personal Data collected are provided in the dedicated sections of this privacy policy or by specific explanation texts displayed prior to the Data collection.

Personal Data may be freely provided by the User, or, in case of Usage Data, collected automatically when using eyezly.me. Unless specified otherwise, all Data requested by eyezly.me is mandatory and failure to provide this Data may make it impossible for eyezly.me to provide its services. In cases where eyezly.me specifically states that some Data is not mandatory, Users are free not to communicate this Data without consequences to the availability or the functioning of the Service.

Users who are uncertain about which Personal Data is mandatory are welcome to contact the Owner.

Any use of Cookies – or of other tracking tools — by eyezly.me or by the owners of third-party services used by eyezly.me serves the purpose of providing the Service required by the User, in addition to any other purposes described in the present document and in the Cookie Policy.

Users are responsible for any third-party Personal Data obtained, published or shared through eyezly.me.

Mode and place of processing the Data

Methods of processing

The Owner takes appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorised access, disclosure, modification, or unauthorised destruction of the Data.

The Data processing is carried out using computers and/or IT enabled tools, following organisational procedures and modes strictly related to the purposes indicated. In addition to the Owner, in some cases, the Data may be accessible to certain types of persons in charge, involved with the operation of eyezly.me (administration, sales, marketing, legal, system administration) or external parties (such as third-party technical service providers, mail carriers, hosting providers, IT companies, communications agencies) appointed, if necessary, as Data Processors by the Owner. The updated list of these parties may be requested from the Owner at any time.

Place

The Data is processed at the Owner's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located.

Depending on the User's location, data transfers may involve transferring the User's Data to a country other than their own. To find out more about the place of processing of such transferred Data, Users can check the section containing details about the processing of Personal Data.

Retention time

Personal Data shall be processed and stored for as long as required by the purpose they have been collected for.

The purposes of processing

The Data concerning the User is collected to allow the Owner to provide its Service, comply with its legal obligations, respond to enforcement requests, protect its rights and interests (or those of its Users or third parties), detect any malicious or fraudulent activity, as well as the following: Infrastructure monitoring, Displaying content from external platforms, Hosting and backend infrastructure, Access to third-party accounts, Registration and authentication, Contacting the User, Social features, Handling

activity data, Interaction with data collection platforms and other third parties, Device permissions for Personal Data access, Registration and authentication provided directly by eyezly.me, Handling payments, Interaction with live chat platforms and Advertising.

For specific information about the Personal Data used for each purpose, the User may refer to the section “Detailed information on the processing of Personal Data”.

Device permissions for Personal Data access

Depending on the User's specific device, eyezly.me may request certain permissions that allow it to access the User's device Data as described below.

By default, these permissions must be granted by the User before the respective information can be accessed. Once the permission has been given, it can be revoked by the User at any time. In order to revoke these permissions, Users may refer to the device settings or contact the Owner for support at the contact details provided in the present document. The exact procedure for controlling app permissions may be dependant on the User's device and software.

Please note that the revoking of such permissions might impact the proper functioning of eyezly.me.

If User grants any of the permissions listed below, the respective Personal Data may be processed (i.e accessed to, modified or removed) by eyezly.me.

Camera permission

Used for accessing the camera or capturing images and video from the device.

Microphone permission

Allows accessing and recording microphone audio from the User's device.

Phone permission

Used for accessing a host of typical features associated with telephony. This enables, for instance, read-only access to the “phone state”, which means it enables access to the phone number of the device, current mobile network information, or the status of any ongoing calls.

Photo Library permission

Allows access to the User's Photo Library.

Detailed information on the processing of Personal Data

Personal Data is collected for the following purposes and using the following services:

Access to third-party accounts

This type of service allows eyezly.me to access Data from your account on a third-party service and perform actions with it. These services are not activated automatically, but require explicit authorisation by the User.

X account access (X Corp.)

This service allows eyezly.me to connect with the User's account on the X social network, provided by X Corp.

Personal Data processed: device information; Trackers; Usage Data; username.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: identifiers; internet information.

Advertising

This type of service allows User Data to be utilised for advertising communication purposes. These communications are displayed in the form of banners and other advertisements on eyezly.me, possibly based on User interests.

This does not mean that all Personal Data are used for this purpose. Information and conditions of use are shown below.

Some of the services listed below may use Trackers to identify Users or they may use the behavioural retargeting technique, i.e.

displaying ads tailored to the User's interests and behaviour, including those detected outside eyezly.me.

Contact form

By filling in the contact form with their Data, the User authorises eyezly.me to use these details to reply to requests for information, quotes or any other kind of request as indicated by the form's header.

Personal Data processed: email address; Usage Data.

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: identifiers; internet information.

Device permissions for Personal Data access

Eyezly.me requests certain permissions from Users that allow it to access the User's device Data as described below.

Displaying content from external platforms

This type of service allows you to view content hosted on external platforms directly from the pages of eyezly.me and interact with them. Such services are often referred to as widgets, which are small elements placed on a website or app. They provide specific information or perform a particular function and often allow for user interaction.

This type of service might still collect web traffic data for the pages where the service is installed, even when Users do not use it.

Google Fonts (Google LLC)

Google Fonts is a typeface visualisation service provided by Google LLC that allows eyezly.me to incorporate content of this kind on its pages.

Personal Data processed: Trackers; Usage Data.

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: internet information.

Adobe Fonts (Adobe Systems Incorporated)

Adobe Fonts is a typeface visualisation service provided by Adobe Systems Incorporated that allows eyezly.me to incorporate content of this kind on its pages.

Personal Data processed: Usage Data; various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: identifiers; internet information.

Handling activity data

This type of service allows the Owner to use the activity or biometric data collected by your device in order for eyezly.me to operate or to provide specific features. This may include movements, heartbeat, change in altitude or data about the surroundings. Depending on what is described below, third parties may be involved in the activity tracking. Most devices allow for the User to control which Data is accessed or stored.

Activity data tracked by your device

Eyezly.me uses some activity data tracked by your device to operate or to provide specific features.

Personal Data processed: general activity data.

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: geolocation data.

Handling payments

Unless otherwise specified, eyezly.me processes any payments by credit card, bank transfer or other means via external payment service providers. In general and unless where otherwise stated, Users are requested to provide their payment details and personal information directly to such payment service providers. Eyezly.me isn't involved in the collection and processing of such information: instead, it will only receive a notification by the relevant payment service provider as to whether payment has been successfully completed.

CCBill (Payments)

CCBill (payment gateway)

CCBill is used to process payments made by users within the Eyezly platform. CCBill collects and processes transaction data for contract fulfilment and security purposes.

Data processed: payment details, email address, IP address, transaction history

Place of processing: United States

Hosting and backend infrastructure

This type of service has the purpose of hosting Data and files that enable eyezly.me to run and be distributed or to provide a ready-made infrastructure to run specific features or parts of eyezly.me.

Some services among those listed below, if any, may work through geographically distributed servers, making it difficult to determine the actual location where the Personal Data are stored.

SiteGround Hosting (SiteGround Hosting Ltd.)

SiteGround Hosting is a hosting service provided by SiteGround Hosting Ltd.

Personal Data processed: Trackers; Usage Data; various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Place of processing: Netherlands – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: identifiers; internet information.

GitHub Pages (GitHub Inc.)

GitHub Pages is a hosting service provided by GitHub, Inc.

Personal Data processed: various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: identifiers.

Amazon Web Services (AWS) (Amazon Web Services, Inc.)

Amazon Web Services (AWS) is a hosting and backend service provided by Amazon Web Services, Inc.

Personal Data processed: various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: identifiers.

Infrastructure monitoring

This type of service allows eyezly.me to monitor the use and behaviour of its components so its performance, operation, maintenance and troubleshooting can be improved.

Which Personal Data are processed depends on the characteristics and mode of implementation of these services, whose function is to filter the activities of eyezly.me.

Sentry (Functional Software, Inc.)

Sentry is a monitoring service provided by Functional Software, Inc. .

Personal Data processed: various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: identifiers.

Interaction with data collection platforms and other third parties

This type of service allows Users to interact with data collection platforms or other services directly from the pages of eyezly.me for the purpose of saving and reusing data.

If one of these services is installed, it may collect browsing and Usage Data in the pages where it is installed, even if the Users do not actively use the service.

Direct marketing via popups (eyezly.me)

Eyezly.me uses popups to interact with the User to propose services and products which may be provided by third parties or that are unrelated to the product or services provided by eyezly.me.

Personal Data processed: various types of Data.

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: identifiers.

Interaction with live chat platforms

This type of service allows Users to interact with third-party live chat platforms directly from the pages of eyezly.me, in order to contact and be contacted by eyezly.me's support service.

If one of these services is installed, it may collect browsing and Usage Data in the pages where it is installed, even if the Users do not actively use the service. Moreover, live chat conversations may be logged.

Getstream.io (live streaming)

Getstream.io (Live Streaming)

Eyezly uses Getstream.io to manage live streaming sessions and real-time interactions between users.

Data processed: username, transmitted content, chat, IP

Place of processing: United States

Registration and authentication

By registering or authenticating, Users allow eyezly.me to identify them and give them access to dedicated services.

Depending on what is described below, third parties may provide registration and authentication services. In this case, eyezly.me will be able to access some Data, stored by these third-party services, for registration or identification purposes.

Some of the services listed below may also collect Personal Data for targeting and profiling purposes; to find out more, please refer to the description of each service.

Google OAuth (Google LLC)

Google OAuth is a registration and authentication service provided by Google LLC and is connected to the Google network.

Personal Data processed: Trackers; Usage Data; various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: identifiers; internet information.

Ondato (identity verification – KYC)

Ondato (identity verification)

Ondato is a service used by Eyezly to verify the identity of Creators for legal compliance purposes (KYC). The processing is carried out to ensure the authenticity of users and prevent illegal behaviour.

Data processed: name, surname, image, identity document, selfie, IP address.

Place of processing: European Union

Registration and authentication provided directly by eyezly.me

By registering or authenticating, Users allow eyezly.me to identify them and give them access to dedicated services. The Personal Data is collected and stored for registration or identification purposes only. The Data collected are only those necessary for the provision of the service requested by the Users.

Direct registration

The User registers by filling out the registration form and providing the Personal Data directly to eyezly.me.

Personal Data processed: email address; password; Trackers; Usage Data.

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: identifiers; internet information.

Social features

Inviting and suggesting friends

Eyezly.me may use the Personal Data provided to allow Users to invite their friends - for example through the address book, if access has been provided - and to suggest friends or connections inside it.

Personal Data processed: various types of Data.

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: identifiers.

Public profile

Users may have public profiles that other Users can display. In addition to the Personal Data provided, this profile may contain Users' interactions with eyezly.me.

Personal Data processed: email address; username.

Category of Personal Information collected according to CCPA: identifiers.

Further information about the processing of Personal Data

Analysis and predictions based on the User's Data ("profiling")

The Owner may use the Personal and Usage Data collected through eyezly.me to create or update User profiles. This type of Data processing allows the Owner to evaluate User choices, preferences and behaviour for the purposes outlined in the respective section of this document. User profiles can also be created through the use of automated tools like algorithms, which can also be provided by third parties. To find out more about the profiling activities performed, Users can check the relevant sections of this document. The User always has a right to object to this kind of profiling activity. To find out more about the User's rights and how to exercise them, the User is invited to consult the section of this document outlining the rights of the User.

Preference Cookies

Preference Cookies store the User preferences detected on eyezly.me in the local domain such as, for example, their timezone and region.

Unique device identification

Eyezly.me may track Users by storing a unique identifier of their device, for analytics purposes or for storing Users' preferences.

User identification via a universally unique identifier (UUID)

Eyezly.me may track Users by storing a so-called universally unique identifier (or short UUID) for analytics purposes or for storing Users' preferences. This identifier is generated upon installation of this Application, it persists between Application launches and updates, but it is lost when the User deletes the Application. A reinstall generates a new UUID.

The Service is not directed to children under the age of 13

Users declare themselves to be adult according to their applicable legislation. Minors may use eyezly.me only with the assistance of a parent or guardian. Under no circumstance persons under the age of 13 may use eyezly.me.

The Service is intended for adults

Users declare themselves to be adult according to their applicable legislation. Minors may not use eyezly.me.

Push notifications

Eyezly.me may send push notifications to the User to achieve the purposes outlined in this privacy policy.

Users may in most cases opt-out of receiving push notifications by visiting their device settings, such as the notification settings for mobile phones, and then change those settings for eyezly.me, some or all of the apps on the particular device. Users must be aware that disabling push notifications may negatively affect the utility of eyezly.me.

Push notifications for direct marketing

Eyezly.me may send push notifications to the User for the purpose of direct marketing (to propose services and products provided by third parties or unrelated to the product or service provided by eyezly.me).

Users may in most cases opt-out of receiving push notifications by visiting their device settings, such as the notification settings for mobile phones, and then changing those settings for eyezly.me or all of the apps on the particular device.

Users must be aware that disabling push notifications may negatively affect the utility of eyezly.me.

Besides applicable device settings, the User may also make use of the rights described under User rights in the relevant section of this privacy policy.

Automated decision-making

Automated decision-making means that a decision which is likely to have legal effects or similarly significant effects on Users, is taken solely by technological means, without any human intervention. Eyezly.me may use the Users' Personal Data to make decisions entirely or partially based on automated processes according to the purposes outlined in this document. Eyezly.me adopts automated decision-making processes as far as necessary to enter into or perform a contract between Users and Owner, or on the basis of the Users' explicit consent, where such consent is required by the law. Automated decisions are made by technological means – mostly based on algorithms subject to predefined criteria – which may also be provided by third parties. The rationale behind automated decision-making is:

to enable or otherwise improve the decision-making process; to grant Users fair and unbiased treatment based on consistent and uniform criteria; to reduce the potential harm derived from human error, personal bias and the like which may potentially lead to discrimination or imbalance in the treatment of individuals etc.; to reduce the risk of Users' failure to meet their obligation under a contract. Consequences of automated decision-making processes for Users and rights of Users subjected to it

As a consequence, Users subject to such processing, are entitled to exercise specific rights aimed at preventing or otherwise limiting the potential effects of the automated decisions taken. In particular, Users have the right to:

obtain an explanation about any decision taken as a result of automated decision-making and express their point of view regarding this decision; challenge a decision by asking the Owner to reconsider it or take a new decision on a different basis; request and obtain from the Owner human intervention on such processing.

Further Information for Users

Legal basis of processing

The Owner may process Personal Data relating to Users if one of the following applies:

- Users have given their consent for one or more specific purposes.
- provision of Data is necessary for the performance of an agreement with the User and/or for any pre-contractual obligations thereof;
- processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Owner is subject;
- processing is related to a task that is carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Owner;
- processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Owner or by a third party.

In any case, the Owner will gladly help to clarify the specific legal basis that applies to the processing, and in particular whether the provision of Personal Data is a statutory or contractual requirement, or a requirement necessary to enter into a contract.

Further information about retention time

Personal Data shall be processed and stored for as long as required by the purpose they have been collected for.

Therefore:

- Personal Data collected for purposes related to the performance of a contract between the Owner and the User shall be retained until such contract has been fully performed.
- Personal Data collected for the purposes of the Owner's legitimate interests shall be retained as long as needed to fulfill such purposes. Users may find specific information regarding the legitimate interests pursued by the Owner within the relevant sections of this document or by contacting the Owner.

The Owner may be allowed to retain Personal Data for a longer period whenever the User has given consent to such processing, as long as such consent is not withdrawn. Furthermore, the Owner may be obliged to retain Personal Data for a longer period whenever required to fulfil a legal obligation or upon order of an authority.

Once the retention period expires, Personal Data shall be deleted. Therefore, the right of access, the right to erasure, the right to rectification and the right to data portability cannot be enforced after expiration of the retention period.

The rights of Users based on the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

Users may exercise certain rights regarding their Data processed by the Owner.

In particular, Users have the right to do the following, to the extent permitted by law:

- **Withdraw their consent at any time.** Users have the right to withdraw consent where they have previously given their consent to the processing of their Personal Data.
- **Object to processing of their Data.** Users have the right to object to the processing of their Data if the processing is carried out on a legal basis other than consent.
- **Access their Data.** Users have the right to learn if Data is being processed by the Owner, obtain disclosure regarding certain aspects of the processing and obtain a copy of the Data undergoing processing.
- **Verify and seek rectification.** Users have the right to verify the accuracy of their Data and ask for it to be updated or corrected.
- **Restrict the processing of their Data.** Users have the right to restrict the processing of their Data. In this case, the Owner will not process their Data for any purpose other than storing it.
- **Have their Personal Data deleted or otherwise removed.** Users have the right to obtain the erasure of their Data from the Owner.
- **Receive their Data and have it transferred to another controller.** Users have the right to receive their Data in a structured, commonly used and machine readable format and, if technically feasible, to have it transmitted to another controller without any hindrance.
- **Lodge a complaint.** Users have the right to bring a claim before their competent data protection authority.

Users are also entitled to learn about the legal basis of Data transfers to a country outside the European Union or to any international organisation governed by public international law or set up by two or more countries, such as the UN, and about the security measures taken by the Owner to safeguard their Data.

If any such transfer takes place, Users can find out more by checking the relevant sections of this document or enquire with the Owner using the information provided in the contact section.

Details about the right to object to processing

Where Personal Data is processed for a public interest, in the exercise of an official authority vested in the Owner or for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Owner, Users may object to such processing by providing a ground related to their particular situation to justify the objection.

Users must know that, however, should their Personal Data be processed for direct marketing purposes, they can object to that processing at any time, free of charge and without providing any justification. Where the User objects to processing for direct marketing purposes, the Personal Data will no longer be processed for such purposes. To learn whether the Owner is processing Personal Data for direct marketing purposes, Users may refer to the relevant sections of this document.

How to exercise these rights

Any requests to exercise User rights can be directed to the Owner through the contact details provided in this document. Such requests are free of charge and will be answered by the Owner as early as possible and always within one month, providing Users with the information required by law. Any rectification or erasure of Personal Data or restriction of processing will be communicated by the Owner to each recipient, if any, to whom the Personal Data has been disclosed unless this proves impossible or involves disproportionate effort. At the Users' request, the Owner will inform them about those recipients.

Further information for Users in Switzerland

This section applies to Users in Switzerland, and, for such Users, supersedes any other possibly divergent or conflicting information contained in the privacy policy.

Further details regarding the categories of Data processed, the purposes of processing, the categories of recipients of the personal data, if any, the retention period and further information about Personal Data can be found in **the section titled "Detailed information on the processing of Personal Data" within this document.**

The rights of Users according to the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection

Users may exercise certain rights regarding their Data within the limits of law, including the following:

- right of access to Personal Data;
- right to object to the processing of their Personal Data (which also allows Users to demand that processing of Personal Data be restricted, Personal Data be deleted or destroyed, specific disclosures of Personal Data to third parties be prohibited);
- right to receive their Personal Data and have it transferred to another controller (data portability);
- right to ask for incorrect Personal Data to be corrected.

How to exercise these rights

Any requests to exercise User rights can be directed to the Owner through the contact details provided in this document. Such requests are free of charge and will be answered by the Owner as early as possible, providing Users with the information required by law.

Further information for Users in Brazil

The grounds on which we process your personal information

We can process your personal information solely if we have a legal basis for such processing. Legal bases are as follows:

- your consent to the relevant processing activities;
- compliance with a legal or regulatory obligation that lies with us;
- the carrying out of public policies provided in laws or regulations or based on contracts, agreements and similar legal instruments;
- studies conducted by research entities, preferably carried out on anonymised personal information;
- the carrying out of a contract and its preliminary procedures, in cases where you are a party to said contract;
- the exercising of our rights in judicial, administrative or arbitration procedures;
- protection or physical safety of yourself or a third party;
- the protection of health – in procedures carried out by health entities or professionals;
- our legitimate interests, provided that your fundamental rights and liberties do not prevail over such interests; and
- credit protection.

Your Brazilian privacy rights

You have the right to:

- obtain confirmation of the existence of processing activities on your personal information;
- access to your personal information;
- have incomplete, inaccurate or outdated personal information rectified;
- obtain the anonymization, blocking or elimination of your unnecessary or excessive personal information, or of information that is not being processed in compliance with the LGPD;
- obtain information on the possibility to provide or deny your consent and the consequences thereof;
- obtain information about the third parties with whom we share your personal information;
- obtain, upon your express request, the portability of your personal information (except for anonymised information) to another service or product provider, provided that our commercial and industrial secrets are safeguarded;
- obtain the deletion of your personal information being processed if the processing was based upon your consent, unless one or more exceptions provided for in art. 16 of the LGPD apply;
- revoke your consent at any time;

- oppose a processing activity in cases where the processing is not carried out in compliance with the provisions of the law;
- request clear and adequate information regarding the criteria and procedures used for an automated decision; and

You will never be discriminated against, or otherwise suffer any sort of detriment, if you exercise your rights.

How to file your request
